

## **Penn Medicine's Translational Research Center is adjacent to and can be accessed through the Perelman Center on the first level.**

### **Driving Directions**

- **From Northeastern Areas**  
From I-95 South, take the Vine Street/Center City Exit, stay left to 676 West (Vine Street Expressway). Follow 676 West to the I-76 East Exit 1, International Airport. Follow I-76 East (Schuylkill Expressway) to Exit 346A, South Street (left exit), and turn right on South Street. Make a left on 34th Street. The Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania is on the right and Penn Tower and the Perelman Center for Advanced Medicine are on the left. Then follow directions below for parking.
- **From the West & Montgomery County**  
Take the Pennsylvania Turnpike to Exit 326, Valley Forge. Take I-76 East (Schuylkill Expressway) approximately 17 miles to Exit 346A, South Street (left exit), and turn right on South Street. Turn left on 34<sup>th</sup> Street. The Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania is on the right and Penn Tower and the Perelman Center for Advanced Medicine are on the left. Then follow directions below for parking.
- **From the North**  
Take I-476 (Northeast Extension) South to Exit 20, Mid-County. Pay the toll and continue south on I-476 to Exit 16A, I-76 East. Follow I-76 East (Schuylkill Expressway) approximately 17 miles to Exit 346A, South Street (left exit), and turn right on South Street. Turn left on 34th Street. The Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania is on the right and Penn Tower and the Perelman Center for Advanced Medicine are on the left. Then follow directions below for parking.
- **From New Jersey**  
Take I-295 to the Walt Whitman Bridge. Follow signs for I-76 West (Schuylkill Expressway) and take Exit 346A, South Street. Turn left on South Street and turn left on 34th Street. The Hospital of the University of Pennsylvania is on the right and Penn Tower and the Perelman Center for Advanced Medicine are on the left. Then follow directions below for parking.

### **Public Transportation**

The following public transportation options are available to assist you in getting to the Perelman Center:

- **Amtrak**  
Amtrak trains stop at 30th Street Station. See SEPTA information below for travel to the hospital from 30<sup>th</sup> Street Station. Taxi service also is available at 30th Street Station.
- **SEPTA Regional Rail**  
The Airport, Marcus Hook-Wilmington, Media-Elwyn and most Glenside-Jenkintown, Warminster and West Trenton trains provide direct service to the University City Station on the Medical Center campus. From other Regional Rail lines, transfer free to the Airport, Marcus Hook-Wilmington, Media-Elwyn and most Glenside-Jenkintown, Warminster and West Trenton trains at 30th Street or Market East stations. Your train ticket is your transfer.
- **LUCY – Loop Through University City**  
The University City District's LUCY shuttle runs to HUP and Penn Tower at 34th and Spruce Streets. The fare is \$2.

- **New Jersey PATCO Trains**

Take the PATCO line to 8th and Market streets. Follow the underground concourse to the SEPTA Market East station. From there, the R1 Airport, R2 Marcus Hook-Wilmington, and R3 Media-Elwyn regional rail lines provide direct service to the University City Station on the HUP campus.

## **Parking at the Perelman Center**

**PLEASE NOTE: There has been a slight change in Parking. Please refer to these directions.**

- Continue down 34<sup>th</sup> Street which becomes Civic Center Blvd.
- Turn left on Health Sciences Drive and immediately enter the parking garage on your right (LOT 51).
- There will be a guard/volunteer/staff person stationed at the gate who may ask you what you are attending to which you will respond the Humor, Heart and Hope Conference.
- Enter the garage and park and then proceed to the garage entrance where you will board a shuttle marked the Humor, Heart and Hope Conference.
- The shuttle will bring you to the main entrance of the Perelman Center.
- Upon entering the Perelman Center take the escalator to the main floor and follow the signs to the Translational Research Building.
- There will be volunteers staffing the garage and the Perelman Center to make these directions as easy as possible. The shuttle will be available to return you to the garage at the conclusion of the program.
- Parking is free but you must have your parking ticket validated at the conference registration table.

**If you have a handicapped license or placard in your car, proceed on Health Sciences Drive to the Perelman Center garage and a volunteer will assist you at the entrance of the garage.**
