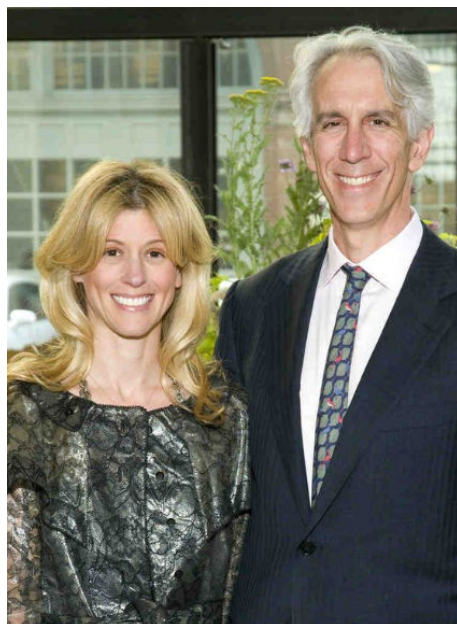
Fashion forward

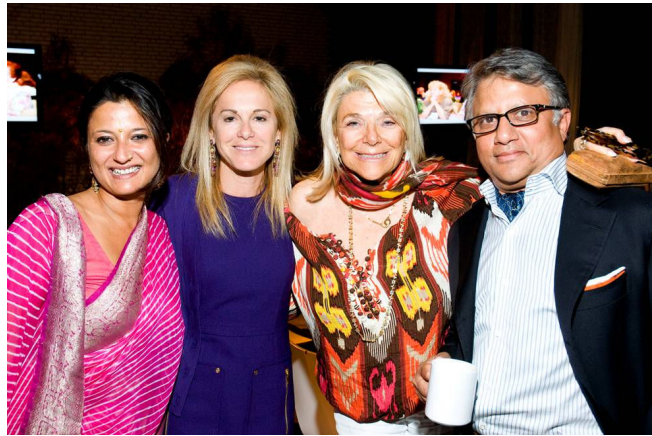
