Built before 1763, Ridgeland Mansion served as a residence for Fairmount Park directors. Now it serves a different purpose. Aside from being a great place to hold a wedding, it now stands for rejuvenation and hope. This complex is now home to The Suzanne Morgan Center at Ridgeland, an award winning non-profit organization that provides support services to people with cancer and their families. The best part is, 100% of the rental fees directly benefit the Cancer Support Community of Philadelphia – a nonprofit organization that provides, at no cost, a professional program of emotional support and education to people whose lives have been impacted by cancer. “A true sanctuary, featuring a contemplation garden, this facility brings healing and hope into the park.”
